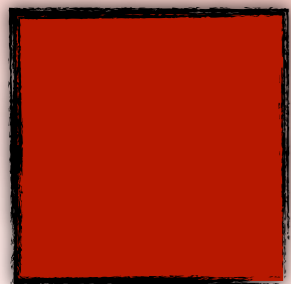

- Laptops



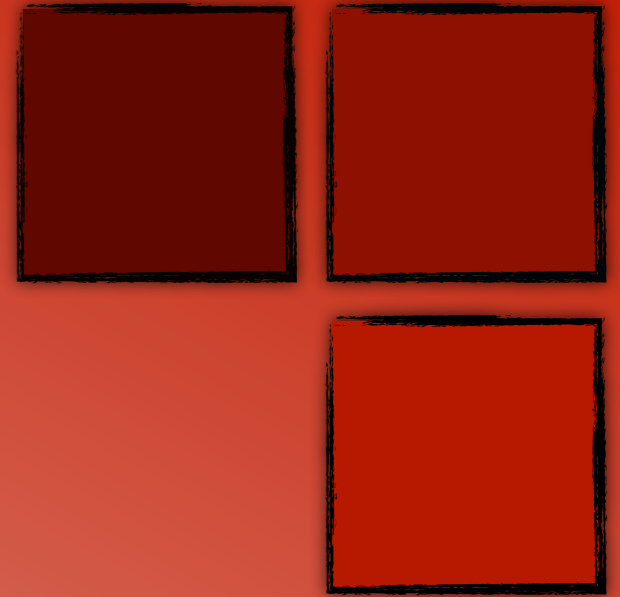
Mobile Devices not Permitted

- MP3 & MP4 players



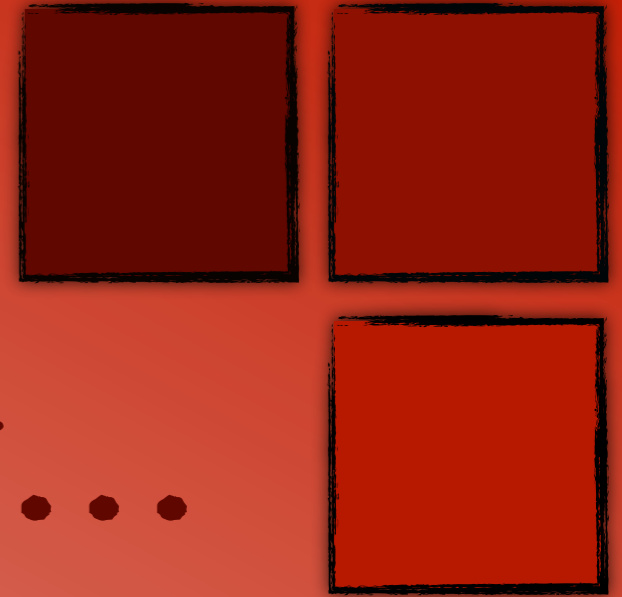
Rationale

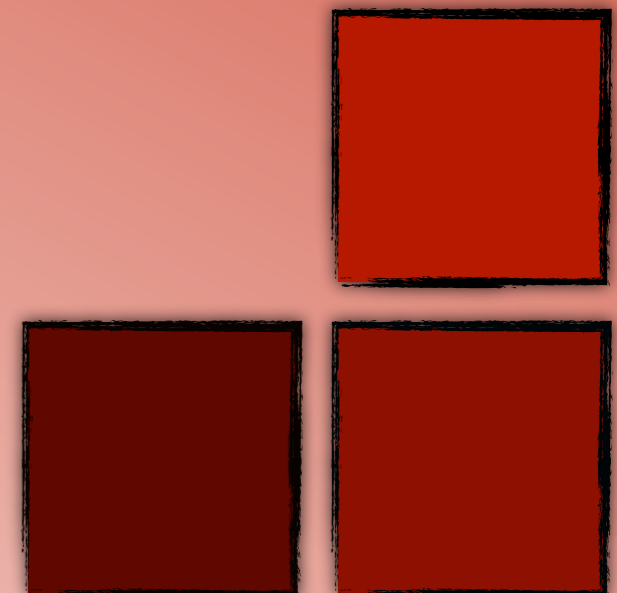


Why BYOD? Cont...

- Pace of MD change - schools cannot keep up-to-date
- Protected C2K wifi now available in most key areas around the school. Traceable digital footprint!

What does BYOD mean for me?

- Y13 & Y14 pupils can now bring their own MD to school, providing they.....
- READ the BYOD Policy (see website) and SIGN the BYOD acceptable user agreement (AUA) at the end of the Policy
- Parent(s)/Guardian(s) MUST sign too

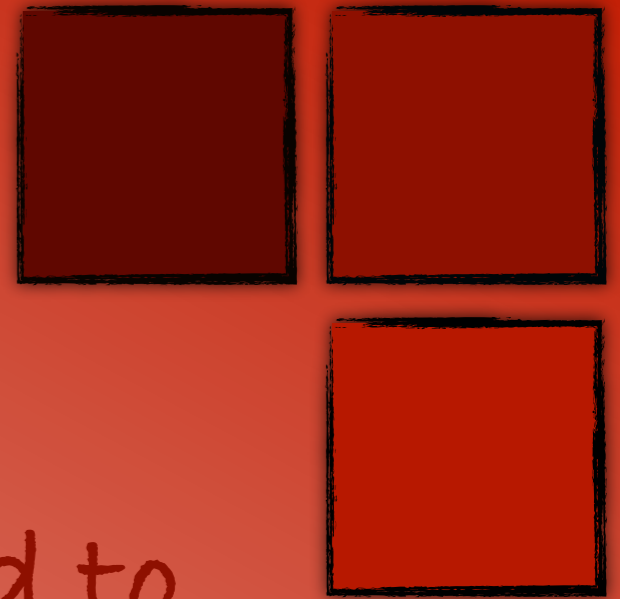

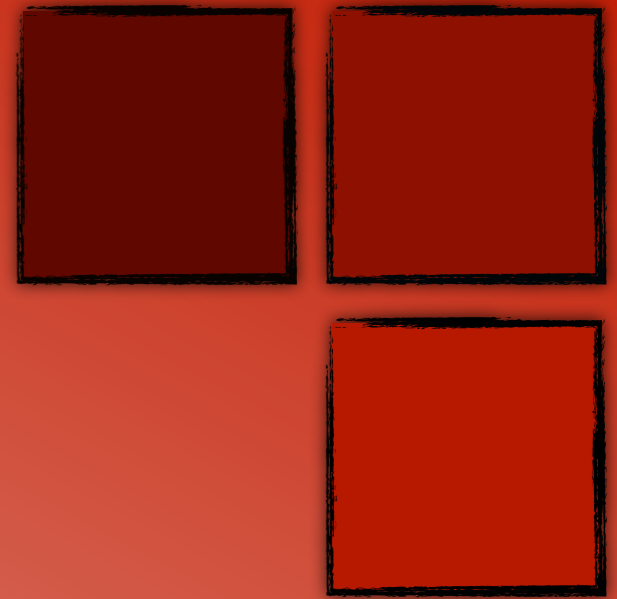
What does BYOD



mean for me? Cont...

- Signed AUAs should be returned to tutors
- Once AUA is handed to your tutor you are able to use your MD FOR SCHOOL USE in the Library or Study Hall whenever a supervisor is present
- You may also use your MD during lessons if your teacher allows.

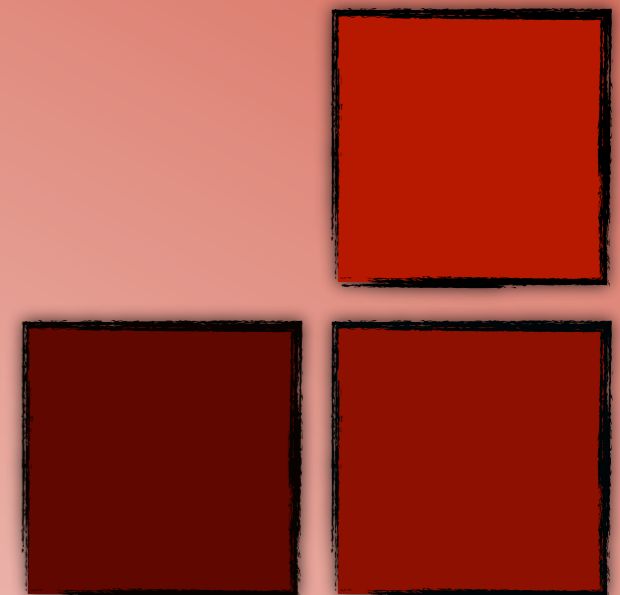
What does BYOD



mean for me? Cont...

- You can join the C2KOpenQuest wifi (instructions on our website). Within 3-5 working days from your AUA being submitted you will be added to the C2KOpenQuest wifi broadcast group.
- A DCF google account will also be created for you over the next few months. It will use your C2K email and give you unlimited cloud storage for school-based work via Google Drive.

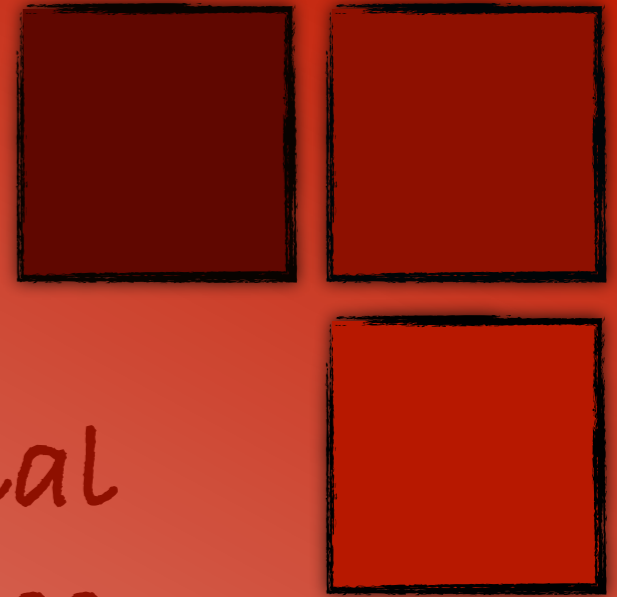
- Read & abide by the BYOD policy - esp. What is permitted and what constitutes improper use
- The MD should be your device - is ONLY for your use (no sharing).
- Be password protected with only access for you
- Be insured and have an appropriate case/cover - the school accepts no liability for loss or damaged devices
- When using wireless - C2KOpenQuest only
- Teacher/supervisor's decision is final
- Think before using - if you think an activity is not allowed trust your gut instinct!
- Back-up all personal data from the MD and removed from MD before first use in school
- Only use school emails to communicate with staff and other pupils about school issues



- Don't ignore or breach the BYOD Policy
- Don't lend or let anyone else borrow your device - ever (no exceptions- even for family members!)
- Never take photos, video or use social media unless directed to do so by a teacher as part of your lessons
- Never use 3/4G or use your phone (or anyone else's!) as a 'hotspot'. You can only use C2KOpenQuest wifi
- Never use your MD in school for anything other than direct school use
- Don't access personal images/video on your MD
- Don't use your MD if you are unsupervised.
- Don't use your MD at BREAK or LUNCH - unless a teacher or supervisor/Librarian present

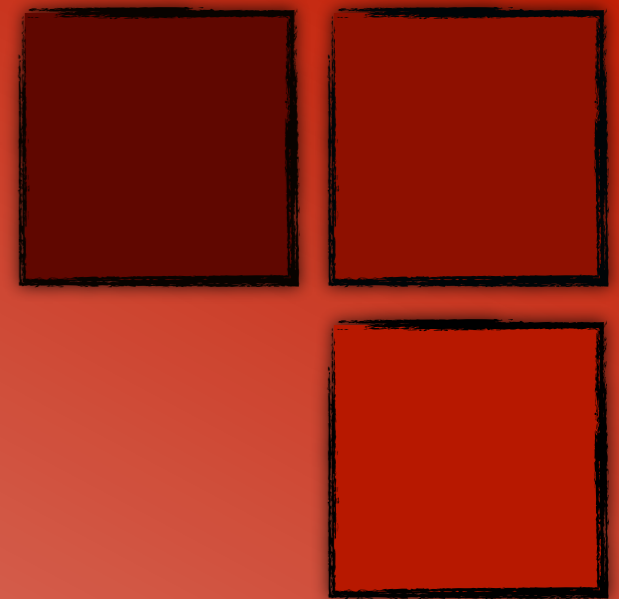


And Remember...



- All staff/supervisors rules are final
- If for any reason a member of staff suspects inappropriate use the device may be left at Reception for safe keeping - see section 4 of the BYOD Policy. Note devices can be searched by a member of the SLT in compliance with the wider E-safety Policy

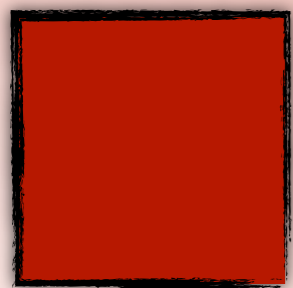
Ongoing Issues
